**DESIGNATION OF CASES FILED AS CIVIL MISCELLANEOUS,
EXCLUDING EXPUNGEMENTS, FOR ELECTRONIC FILING
PURSUANT TO SUPERIOR COURT CIVIL RULE 79.1**

This 11th day of August, 2011:

As the first state court in the nation to implement electronic filing in 1991, the Superior Court has direct experience with eFiling through LexisNexis File & Serve with the speed, efficiency, storage savings and cost savings that electronic filing provides the Court, counsel and litigants. Eventually the system will apply to all civil filings in the Superior Court. This Directive is made to expand the use of eFiling to all cases filed as Civil Miscellaneous, excluding Expungements.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS DIRECTED as follows:
