## AMENDMENT TO E-FILING AND SERVICE CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER TO ADD MIDSTREAM CASES MASTER CASE NUMBER 14-C-3001

The Marcellus Shale Litigation Midstream Master Case file shall contain only pleadings or

documents of general applicability to all midstream cases in the Marcellus Shale Litigation,
such as trial calendars, case management orders, other orders of general applicability, notices of
deposition if they are not case-specific, master pleadings, master discovery and other similar
documents.

When a document is intended to be applicable to all midstream cases in the Marcellus Shale Litigation, the title page of the document shall contain the notation "THIS DOCUMENT

APPLIES TO ALL MIDSTREAM CASES" and the document shall be filed in the Midstream

Master Case Number 14-C-3001.

When a document is intended to be applicable to a specific midstream case or cases the

title page of the document shall contain the notation "THIS DOCUMENT APPLIES TO . . . . ",

and the case or cases shall be listed separately using the initiating case number(s) with the three-

letter county identifier.

All other provisions of the Court's Electronic Filing and Service Case Management

Order (Transaction ID 56485649) remain in full force and effect.

It is so ORDERED.
