1 Pursuant to the Stipulation of the Parties and good cause appearing therefor,

2 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, as of the date hereof, pursuant to the Arizona Rules of

3 Civil Procedure, all attorneys who have appeared on behalf of their respective parties ("counsel of

4 record") in this case shall use LexisNexis File & Serve ("File & Serve") to serve any and all

5 pleadings and discovery-related documents requiring service on counsel of record. Each attorney

6 may also use File & Serve to serve correspondence.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that File & Serve shall be the only method of service

8 considered as valid and effective on all designated recipients pursuant to the Arizona Rules of Civil

9 Procedure, inclusive.

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that every pleading, document and instrument served

11 electronically shall bear a facsimile or typographical signature of at least one of the attorneys of

12 record, along with the typed name, address, telephone number and Bar of Arizona number of such

13 attorney. Typographical signatures shall be treated exactly as personal signatures for purposes of

14 electronically served documents under the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

15 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, to address any training or technical questions that may

16 arise during the course of this litigation, File & Serve will have available to counsel of record and

17 the Court a 24-hour 7-days a week Customer Support resource at (888) 529-7587. In addition, each

18 attorney is instructed to be or become familiar with the procedure for registration with and service

19 through File & Serve.

20 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, within five (5) days of this Order or five (5) days of the

21 initiation of a new case in the litigation, plaintiff's or liaison counsel to LexisNexis shall submit via

22 email to LexisNexis, [Eservice@fileandserve.lexisnexis.com](mailto:Eservice@fileandserve.lexisnexis.com) a complete and current service list of

23 counsel of record for this litigation. Within five (5) days of this Order, each attorney of record for

24 this litigation, or within five (5) days of the entry of appearance for a new attorney of record, shall



**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Counsel shall be liaison counsel to LexisNexis for all service list changes.
