WHEREAS, by order entered on August 10, 2009, the Mass Litigation Panel ("Panel") determined that it was appropriate for IN RE: TOBACCO LITIGATION (INDIVIDUAL PERSONAL INJURY CASES) ("Tobacco Personal Injury Litigation") to be subject to electronic service ("e- service"); and


